FRIDAY, MARCH 2:

Mike gets to the shop about 11. Feel free to pester him.

1:00-4:00 -- I will be somewhere in the midst handing out ride packets if you are in Friday afternoon. Stop by Easy Street and ask Mike where Sweet P and I are hanging.

1:00 ish to 3 ish, a group plans to storm the Veloway. Should be a lot of fun riding around in circles. Love that Veloway!!!!
